A song, "Where Your Treasure Is," in the Gather book says:

Where your treasure is, there your heart shall be.

All that you possess will never set you free.

Seek the things that last; come and learn from me.

Where your treasure is, your heart shall be.

I think this is the message in this weekend's Gospel reading of the rich man whose attachment to his possessions is for nothing. Instead we are asked to seek the things that last. We are invited to come and learn from God – to focus on God and get our priorities in order. The Bible has been around for a while. And we can learn from God by studying the Bible.

There are many ways to study the Bible. I have heard of people who will open the Bible and start reading from the first page of Genesis and work their way to the last page of Revelation. Others have studied the Bible by reflecting on the Sunday Scriptures. Still others have used self-study guides to concentrate on one book of the Bible. There are daily meditations, on-line resources, reference books and computer based programs – all to help us know God's word. And then there are some who choose not to study the Bible formally and rely on the Liturgy of the Word at Mass.

These are good ways to learn about God's word. I am really enjoying our Tuesday evening Bible Study group. There are anywhere from 4 to 10 of us. Some have rarely opened the Bible
