Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Musings from the Pastoral Center by Fr. Gary

Over the past few weeks I have had a number of people ask me; 'Are you happy to be back in Northern Wisconsin?' The answer is a definite **YES!** Six years ago when I was asked to go to Louisiana after one of our friars had died, I found myself desiring to enter into this new ministry but at the same time I had a feeling of loss for the wonderful people and the beauty I left behind. After serving five years in the heat, the humidity and finding myself experiencing more allergies, I was relieved to have a change in scenery. This past year as I was gifted with the opportunity to take a sabbatical for my 25th year as a Franciscan I came to see the idea of Sabbath in a different light.

For the Hebrew community the Sabbath was the seventh day of the week, the day when God looked down, saw the goodness of creation and rested. For Christians the Sabbath was the first day of the week, the day of the resurrection, a day to celebrate Jesus victory over death. It was a day to let go of all the daily cares and ask the Lord into one's life.

Isn't it interesting for a society that prides itself on creating some of the most intelligent minds in the universe, how we continue to push ourselves to the limits. We strive to become successful by cutting back on our sleep while in some cases working more than sixty hours or even over one hundred and twenty hours a week to get ahead of one another. It makes sense why many people find their lives out of rhythm. They find themselves cutting back on sleep, working later hours trying to accomplish more and more. We find them trying to cut corners to get the edge on others so they can stay out in front.

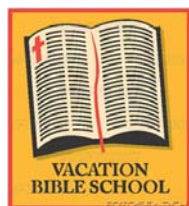
