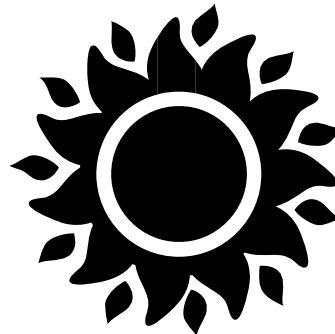
Headstart On The Holiday Bazaar...
