The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ

Whenever there is a celebration there is food. How many graduation parties have you gone to without any food being served? There would not be a Knights of Columbus event without food. Birthday parties, weddings and even funerals all are centered, in part, around a meal.

Meals not only feed our bodies and provide sustenance; they are also social hours that meet our need for belonging. We are part of a community in celebration when a meal is included.

This week the church celebrates the meal of the Eucharist in a special way – the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. This solemnity offers an opportunity to focus on the meaning of the Eucharistic celebration. Among other things, the Eucharist brings the church together and sustains it. It makes real the basic mystery of the Christian faith – the saving death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. It provides spiritual food and empowers believers to follow Christ.

The meals at birthday parties and wedding celebrations provide a very human need of belonging to a family and give us nourishment for the body. However, it is the Body of Blood of Christ in the Eucharist that brings us to communion with God and everlasting life.
