Easter

Musings from the Pastoral Center by Fr Paul

Alleluia, Alleluia, the Lord is Risen!

In the last six weeks, the Alleluia has been silent. The only time during the Church year when we do not say, pray, or sing this word. It is another form of fasting from a word which is rich in meaning and it's sound is pleasing to the ears. We are acquainted with Handel's Messiah in which the highpoint of this wonderful musical experience is when everyone stands and listens, joins in, or simply are moved by the Alleluia chorus. In our own ritual tradition, intoning the Alleluia is the highpoint of the Easter Vigil Service.

This Hebrew word, *hallelujah*, is an invitation for all peoples to sing praise and to boast in God. "Hallelujah" is primarily found in the thanksgiving Psalm 118. Several verses refer to the salvation work of God within the history of humanity and creation. It foreshadows the wonders of God in the fulfillment of the promised Messiah. "I shall not die, but live and declare the works of the Lord" (v.17). "This is the day the Lord has made, let us be glad and rejoice in it" (v. 24). God not only fulfilling the promise of salvation but giving us life forever as well.

Easter is a time of being born into new life again. We know the power of death in our lives. We also know that life is stronger than death. Life is indeed stronger than any disappointment, failure, disaster, sickness, woes, or evil. This is the basis of our faith as Christians. Our physical life here on earth may come to an end due to these threatening agents of death. But God's promise of "you shall not die but live...in the day of the Lord... is an eternal life experience for all of us. A promise fulfilled in the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. An experience in which we will continue to live, sing, praise, be happy, and be completely satisfied in the God of life and promise. A life in which we need not fast anymore from the word "Alleluia."
