Musings from the Pastoral Center by Fr. Gary

We are one half of the way through our Lenten Journey. How are you doing? Are you still following the disciplines you considered doing to help you reflect on the Lord and to become a better person this Lent? Or have those good intentions just moved by the wayside with all the happenings of the world around you? If you have been faithful over these weeks since Ash Wednesday, we are told that you are well on the way to forming good habits to help you to live your life as a follower of Christ. If for some reason you have become sidetracked, you still have three more weeks to begin again. It's important to note that God wants people who strive to be faithful and God knows that we are not perfect and will fail. It is also in three weeks that we will welcome into full membership, our brothers and sisters who have been preparing to receive the sacraments in preparation through the RCIA. Let us continue to keep them in our prayers.

Communication is difficult at best! Last fall the staff realized that the school was not receiving important phone messages at night and two of the staff members also were not receiving messages. These along with other concerns were raised by members of the staff and parishioners. Over the past few months we have been trying to make the system easier to use. One change from the past is the use of three digits for the extensions to insure that you can dial an extension from anywhere in the system and be transferred to your party. You can also wait and listen to the directory when you call to find your extension. We hope that this will lead to better communication between callers with our parish and school.
