## Musings from the Pastoral Center

This is a time for me to reminisce. Clarence Campbell will be ordained into the permanent diaconate in a short two weeks (Aug 14) and I can't help but recall my ordination. This weekend marks my third year anniversary as a permanent deacon. Really, I should be saying 'our' instead of 'my' when I speak of the sacrament of Holy Orders that was conferred on me three years ago. It was God's grace given not only to me but also to my wife, my family and to this community. We witnessed it when Deacon Owen was ordained and we will be witnessing it again when my friend, Clarence, is ordained.

My memory of the ordination is scattered - very much like our wedding day - I know it happened but I don't really remember everything. However, there are a few things that strike me as being very powerful. My daughter sang the Litany of the Saints while I lay prostrate at the altar. The Bishop's Laying on of Hands (the matter) and the words he says (the form) make the sacrament valid. In part the Bishop, with his hands on me, calls upon the Lord to "look with favor on this servant of yours, whom we now dedicate to the office of deacon, to minister at your holy altar... May he excel in every virtue: in love that is sincere, in concern for the sick and the poor, in unassuming authority, in self-discipline and in holiness in life."

I recall the presentation of the Book of the Gospels, which was placed in my hands. The Bishop prays again, "Receive the Gospel of Christ, whose herald you now are. Believe what you read, teach what you believe, and practice what you teach." Those were my memories and I suspect Clarence will have his own memories and his own powerful moments.

I have known Clarence since I moved to Ashland nearly 25 years ago. We played city softball as members of the KC team. I was in community theatre with him and many members of his family. Clarence is a good man and will make a good deacon. I am proud to call Clarence my friend. It is this community that has supported him and Kaye as they prepared for this day and all the days to follow. I encourage you all to attend Clarence's ordination and celebrate this very special day with him and Kaye and their children. Witness the richness of this sacrament.
